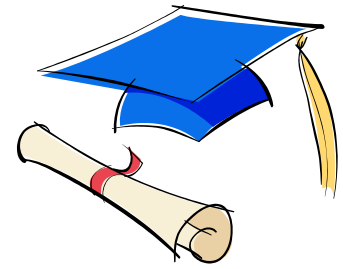


SEEKING APPLICANTS FOR COLLEGE SCHOLARSHIPS



THE FUND

The Sherry S. Hintz Scholarship Fund was created by an anonymous Montgomery County resident in memory of several women in her family who lost their lives to breast cancer. The Fund provides college scholarship awards to students who have lost a parent/guardian to breast or ovarian cancer. The Fund is administered through the **Community Foundation for Montgomery County (CFMC)** in partnership with the **Mental Health Association (MHA) of Montgomery County, Maryland.**

AWARD AVAILABILITY AND DEADLINE

Awardees of the Sherry S. Hintz Scholarship Fund may receive up to \$20,000 per year for as many as four years of undergraduate education. All applications and attachments must be postmarked by March 5, 2012.

ELIGIBILITY

You may be eligible if you:

- Are a resident of Montgomery County, Maryland
- Are a member of a family with a demonstrated financial need
- Are a high school junior, senior, or a high school graduate under 22 years old
- Have achieved at least a 3.0 GPA
- Are involved in a school, community, or athletic activity, ideally in a leadership position
- Have lost a parent or primary guardian to breast or ovarian cancer
- Wish to attend college
