

Dementia, Delirium, & Depression in Older Adults

Event Summary: This program will enhance participants' knowledge of Dementia, Delirium, Depression and suicide as they relate to older adults. Participants will be able to effectively differentiate the variability in the diagnoses and their symptomatology. Attendees will learn about key assessment tools that aid in the practitioners' ability to accurately identify Dementia, Delirium and Depression, as well as methods to provide continual re-assessment to address the changing needs of their clients. This interactive program will help participants incorporate practical methods in their day to day work with older adults with Dementia, Delirium, Depression and/or suicidal ideation.

This program will address the role of the family caregiver and his or her perspective as it relates to Dementia, Delirium, Depression and suicide. Participants will learn strategies to support family caregivers and promote caregivers' understanding of the diagnoses being discussed. Ethical issues of capacity, self determination and confidentiality will be explored.

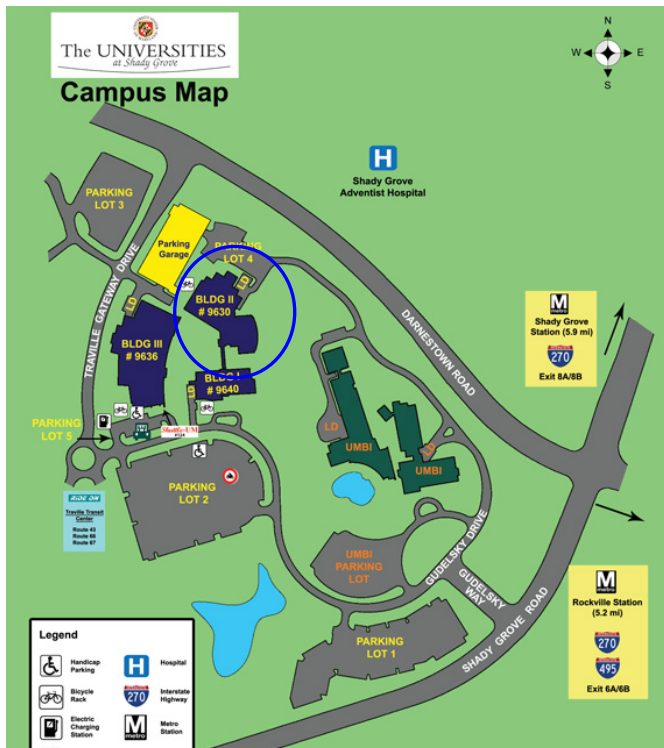
